

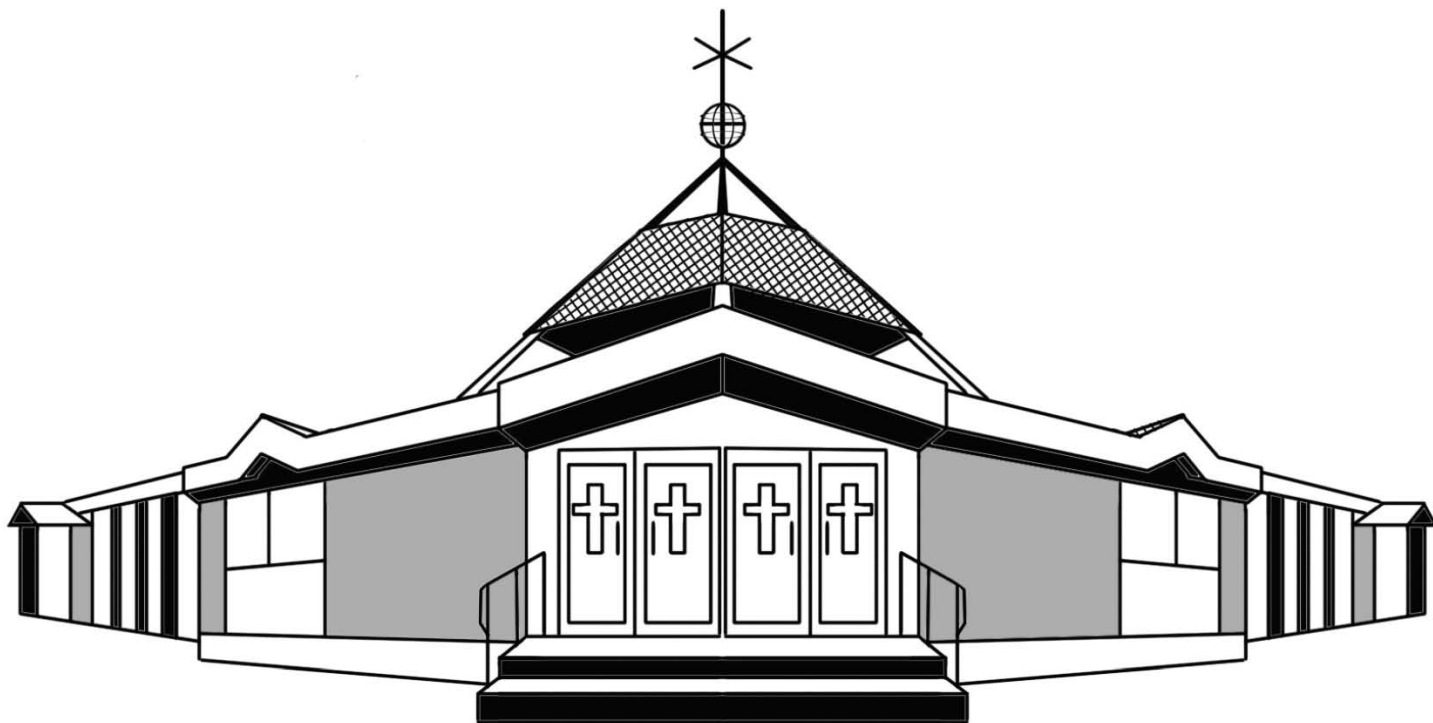

Update from the Diocese of Hamilton Regarding Fr. Ranjan D'Sa OCD

The Diocese of Hamilton has provided an update regarding Fr. Ranjan D'Sa, OCD, who has served as Pastor of St. Dominic Parish, Oakville

In March 2026 Fr. D'Sa was charged with one count of sexual assault. Throughout the matter, Fr. D'Sa maintained his innocence and was presumed innocent while the legal process proceeded.

On July 24, 2026, the charge was withdrawn at the request of the Crown Attorney's Office, and Fr. D'Sa has no outstanding criminal charges. The Diocese has subsequently restored his priestly faculties, effective August 6, 2026, and has confirmed that he is a priest in good standing with the faculties necessary to exercise his priestly ministry according to the wishes of his Religious Community.

The Diocese has made this information public in order to communicate the outcome of the matter and assist in restoring Fr. D'Sa's reputation.
